

assignment #9: emotion

Create a composition that describes and/or evokes a particular emotion. You can choose a primary emotion (e.g. fear, anger, disgust, surprise, sadness, happiness) or a more complex social emotion (e.g. sympathy, embarrassment, shame, guilt, pride, jealousy, envy, gratitude, admiration, indignation, contempt).

Carefully consider and choose the elements you use to describe the emotion:

- Light & color
- Tempo
- Rhythm
- Juxtaposition & ordering
- Facial expression
- Gesture
- Action/plot
- Dialogue/voiceover
- Music

The composition should include visuals and sound; media is up to you - video, still images, drawn/scanned elements are all OK. You may **NOT** use prerecorded music or text.
